### PERMANENTLY CLOSE COUNCIL PUBLIC ROAD FACT SHEET

### **BEFORE YOU BEGIN**

## Stage 1 - Council Public Road Closure Application: Undertake Preliminary Site Investigations (Non-Refundable) \*

This form is used to complete preliminary investigations into the proposal to formally close the road. In determining your application, Council will confirm:

- The road is not reasonably required as a road for public use (whether for present of future needs) and;
- The road is not required to provide the continuity for an existing road network and;
- If the road provides means of vehicular access to particular land, another public road provides lawful and reasonable practicable vehicular access to that land
- Road status and vesting

# Stage 2 - Council Public Road Closure Application: Statutory Advertising, Dealing with Submissions and Report to Council (Non-Refundable) \*

In determining your application, Council will:

- Progress notification requirements under the Roads Act 1993. Section 38B
- Review Objections
- Compilation of the second and final report to Council seeking a resolution to approve or reject the application

## Stage 3 - Council Public Road Closure Application: Finalising Survey, Legal Documents and Preparing Road Closure Notice for Government Gazette \*

Used to finalise the formal closure for sale and transfer. Applicants must pay the final application fee for Stage 3, however additional costs will apply for the following:

- Surveyor Costs
- Valuation Costs
- Legal Costs
- Land Purchase Cost

**Note:** applicant will be required to pay all of Council's costs including Councils legal, survey, and statutory advertising fees in order to have the Council public road closed.

**Note:** when an unconstructed Council public road is closed it becomes vested in the Crown as Crown Land. In these instances Council is not able to facilitate the sale of Crown Land with the applicant. Any discussions regarding purchase should be directed to NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment - Crown Lands.

**Note:** when a constructed Council public road is closed it remains vested in Council as Council land. The applicant will be required to pay all of Council's costs including legal, valuation costs and the agreed compensation. The applicant will also be required to pay any survey costs to consolidate the closed road within their own land upon transfer.

You will need to agree and acknowledge that the application (Stage 1) is to investigate if the road can be progressed for potential closure. This does not guarantee that the road will be closed and available for purchase. Formal approval/refusal of the proposed road closure does not occur until Stage 2.
