Standard Conditions for Busking Applications
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> No person shall busk without being in possession of a current letter of permission to busk. The Approval or letter of permission to busk, if issued, will have a duration of one month, one week, one month or one year. A busker shall not operate for more than (2) days in the same week. A busker MUST consult with shopkeeper/s, if they are not forthcoming, the busker MUST seek an alternative site. A busker must perform on the gutter edge of the footpath and not encroach onto the footpath more than one (1) metre. A busker must not perform in any location for any length of time in excess of (1) hour. A busker must not use electric or amplified music and the noise level from a distance of three (3) metres shall not be more than 7dBA above the background noise. A busker MUST NOT accost pedestrians with requests for money but may display a receptacle for donations. Signs, posters or requests must not be displayed. <p>Permission to busk is subject to immediate revocation for the non-observation of any of the above requirements or on complaint from shopkeepers or pedestrians.</p>
