Due to health concerns, **all library branches are now closed to the public**. Staff continue to work behind closed doors and are available to answer your phone calls and email enquiries.

NEW RESERVE AND COLLECT SERVICE

Library members are now able to reserve items through our new library app for [iPhone](#) or [Android](#), online through the [Member Services](#) page of our Catalogue, by sending an email to enquiries@richmondvalley.nsw.gov.au or by phoning their [local branch](#).

Members will be contacted via their preferred method when the reserves are ready to collect from their local branch.

Collection times are as follows:

Casino: Monday to Friday, 9 to 10.30am or 12.30 to 2.30pm

Coraki: Tuesday and Thursday, 2 to 5pm

Evans Head: Monday to Friday, 9am to 5pm

Kyogle: Tuesday to Friday, 10am to 5pm

When you arrive at the library to collect your reserves, we would appreciate it if you could call us. This will help us maintain social distancing.

We have increased the loan limit to 30 items at one time and the borrowing period is now 42 days (6 weeks).

We are currently investigating a similar reserve service for the Mobile Library and hope to have it operational soon.




