Where the notification was verbal, a written notification using this form must be submitted within seven days. The person responsible is the person who has management and control of the UPSS.

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This form should be completed where at least one of the following scenarios apply to the UPSS site									
☐ A leak from a UPSS, verified in accordance with loss detection or incident management procedures, that is causing or threatens material harm to human health or the environment.									
☐ There is evidence on the site of free-phase hydrocarbons in surface water and/or groundwater.									
☐ There is evidence that offsite migration of hydrocarbons could occur, is occurring, or has occurred.
