Meanwhile the temporary Evans Head Library continues to operate out of the Visitor Information Centre with three public internet PCs available for use. Opening Hours are Monday-Friday 8.30am-4.30pm and Saturday 9am-12noon.



Mobile Library Service

Did you know our Mobile Library:

- Is operated by Steve Locke
- Serves the communities of Richmond Valley Council and Kyogle Council rural communities covering a total of 6,640 square kilometres
- Travels 750kms per week or 3,100kms per month.
- There are approximately 3,500 items on board

- The total length of the mobile library is 12 metres
- Has two free public internet pcs
- Has free WIFI
- Delivers freight weekly to the other 4 libraries
- Departs and returns daily to the Richmond Valley Council Depot in Casino
- Can run tech savvy sessions
- Schedule is reviewed every quarter
- Copies of the schedule are available at all libraries and library website
- Includes 19 schedules stops over a fortnight plus 2 monthly stops

Save Power Kits

Both Richmond Valley Council and Kyogle Council are members of the NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment's Sustainable Councils and Communities Program (SCC).

As part of their community outreach work the SCC program is relaunching what is known as the Save Power Kit project. The Kits are designed to assist residents to identify potential energy savings in their own home.

The Save Power Kits have been distributed to Councils and are now available for loan from Casino Library (two kits) and Kyogle Library (two kits).
