


Beamafilm User Guide




How do I watch online films?


Go to Beamafilm on the library website <https://bit.ly/rucrlcat> or download the app from the app store



Using the app or a computer/laptop search for the "Richmond-Upper Clarence (richmond valley) Library", then enter your library card number beginning with R, then click "Sign Up".




If you don't have a Beamafilm account you will be asked to sign up.
Just enter your personal details to create your account.




